Online

Participants from different industries can bounce different ideas off each other and together, break old molds and create new, innovative business solutions.

Impactful Output

Participants will be guided through the entire process of building a solid business plan from mere ideas. They will be trained on the important skills necessary for making effective pitch presentations with a focus on practical and impactful final output.

Inspiration + **Business** Creation

Furthermore, we will arrange exchanges with organizations such as EDB (Singapore Economic Development Board) and BLOCK71% so that we can provide participants with inspiration as well as opportunities for networking and transforming their business ideas into reality. **BLOCK71 is an ecosystem builder and global connector with incubators (250 startups, 30 incubators/investors/venture capitals).



Turning ideas into business plans




• Learn how to create effective pitch presentations

- "Pitch" comes from the phrase "elevator pitch", whereas you try to present your ideas to a senior executive as precisely and convincingly as possible and get his/her buy-in all within 15 seconds.
- In other words, it means to express the appeal of something in a short amount of time.

• Learn how to organize and present your ideas in a visually appealing way

- Turn exciting ideas and information into easy-to-understand presentations using pictures and illustrations.
- Be able to present your vision and business model like a story with just 10 slides. Each slide resembles a manga frame that tells a part of the story. The trick is to focus on each of those frames while also creating an overall flow that ties all the elements together.
